

2019 Football July 17 Meeting Talking Points

New Rule Changes-Updates

- 5 on the Line of Scrimmage—4 in Backfield (U, L, LJ)
- Tripping the runner is now prohibited. It will be a foul to intentionally use the lower leg or foot to obstruct a runner below the knees.
- The “horse-collar” foul was expanded to include the name-plate area, which is directly below the back collar.
- Illegal “kicking or batting the ball” penalty reduced from 15 yards to 10 yards
- 40/25 Second Clock—Table Review ..\Pictures\Saved Pictures\40-25 Play Clock Guide.jpg

A major change is a 40-second play clock, which will start when the ball is declared dead by an official from the previous play. The play clock will continue to start at 25 seconds in six instances:

- • Prior to a try following a score
- • To start a period or overtime series
- • Following administration of an inadvertent whistle
- • Following a charged timeout
- • Following an official’s timeout, with a few exceptions
- • Following the stoppage of the play clock by the referee for any other reason
